# UNDERSTANDING HONORS ENRICHMENTS

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**Honors Enrichments** provide additional continuity within Central's Honors Program that helps intellectually sustain honors-eligible students in addition to their experiences with Intersections Honors Seminars, Honors Seminars, and Senior Honors Theses. Essentially, an Honors Enrichment is a 1 semester hour add-on to an existing course and is taken to augment and amplify the coursework an honors student experiences concurrently in their course.

For example, in a given term a student might be registered for *ENGL 236: American Literature I* for 3 s.h.; that student, if honors-eligible and seeking additional, more in-depth, honors-level study in conjunction with that course, could also request registration in *ENGL 236H: American Literature I* for 1 s.h. That additional 1 semester hour of credit might be fulfilled through additional readings, research, essays, tests, and/or some other means deemed appropriate by the instructor of ENGL 236. At the completion of the term, the student would receive individual grades for each course and individual credit amounts for each course – 3 s.h. for ENGL 236, and 1 s.h. for ENGL 236H.

Not all courses will lend themselves, either academically or logistically, to having Honors Enrichments developed in conjunction with them. Accordingly, close communication with course instructors and advisors is critical in determining whether or not a particular Honors Enrichment is viable.

## REGISTERING FOR HONORS ENRICHMENT

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### To register for an Honors Enrichment:

1. The student should discuss with the instructor the feasibility of adding-on an Honors Enrichment to a course.
2. Complete the ***Honors Enrichment Registration Form*** (see reverse side of this sheet) in its entirety. The title and course number of any Honors Enrichment will be the title of the course to which it is associated. For example, an Honors Enrichment to the course *ENGL 236: American Literature I* will be named *ENGL 236H: American Literature I*.
3. Obtain all required signatures. *No application will be accepted without each required signature.*
4. Submit the completed and signed ***Honors Enrichment Registration Form*** to the chair of the faculty Honors Committee. The committee will review all proposed enrichments.
