

COURSE EQUIVALENCY GUIDE FOR IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGES

Making sure the credits you have already earned will transfer toward a degree at Central is a prime concern. All courses will be considered for transfer credit if they meet the criteria detailed below. To be eligible for consideration, all potential transfer courses:

- Must have been completed with a final grade of at least "C"
- Must have been earned at a regionally accredited college or university.
- Must be an official transcript submitted directly to Central from the institution where the courses were taken.
- Must be similar in content, purpose, academic perspective, and rigor to courses at Central (as determined by the Central College faculty).

The Registrar's Office will officially evaluate your transfer credits after you have submitted an official transcript and have been admitted to Central.

- Credits approved for transfer can be applied to meet:
 - Core requirements
 - Major requirements
 - Total 120 credit necessary for BA completion; BS completion requires 124, 136, or 150 depending on major.
 - Or a combination of all three

Students who matriculate PRIOR TO August 2024:

- Students may transfer in up to 24 semester hours maximum of dual credit, AP, or IB credits taken while in high school.
- A maximum of 60 total semester hours of transfer credit may be applied toward completion of a Central College Degree.
- ♦ No vocational or technical credits will be accepted for transfer.

Students who matriculate in August of 2024 or later:

- A maximum of 75 total semester hours of transfer credit may be applied toward completion of a Central College Degree.
- ◆ There is no maximum set for dual credit, AP or IB credits taken while in high school.
- ♦ A maximum of 16 credits of vocational/ technical credit may be allowed in the total of 75.

Below is a list of *frequently transferred* lowa community college courses and their standard equivalent course at Central College, along with the Central academic Core requirement the course meets. This is not an exhaustive, comprehensive list. If you do not see a course which you have either taken or are interested in taking, please contact your admission representative (for prospective students) or the Registrar's Office (for current students) for an updated equivalency for that course.

Important: Courses at both Central and the community colleges change every year, and even within a given year; accordingly, the equivalencies listed below can change frequently. This is only a guide, and not a transfer equivalency contract. This guide will be updated as frequently as possible, but you are always encouraged and advised to contact your admission representative (for prospective students) or the Registrar's Office (for current students) to determine how a particular course taken in a particular term will transfer to Central and what academic requirement it may, at that time, fulfill.
